



POSITION TITLE: Part-Time Mental Health Counselor

PART-TIME POSITION: 15 hours/week from Sept – May

INSTITUTION DESCRIPTION:

Founded in Brooklyn in 1916, the College is independent and coeducational. The mission of St. Joseph's College is to provide a strong academic and value-oriented education rooted in a liberal arts tradition that supports provision for career preparation and enhancement. The Brooklyn Campus serves a population of approx. 1,500 students who live within commuting distance to the college, or reside in off campus student housing.

POSITION DESCRIPTION:

The Office of Counseling and Wellness at St. Joseph's College, Brooklyn seeks qualified applicants for a part time counseling position in the Office of Counseling & Wellness. The position requires 15 hours per week. The counselor will provide direct psychological services to the college student population. The primary service is brief individual therapy but may also include group therapy, couples therapy, crisis intervention, outreach, consultation, and educational workshops. The counselor will also provide support to the overall goals of the office by participating in weekly and case conferences. This is a 9 month position (September – May). Hours will require two full days. Flexibility in scheduling hours will occasionally be required (early morning, evening and/or weekend hours) in order that counselor can attend meetings, and provide outreach services as needed throughout the year. The Office of Counseling and Wellness staff primarily works within a short-term therapy model, while also incorporating experiential, holistic and mindfulness based approaches. Staff are encouraged and supported to engage in continued self- development. We have a warm, supportive, collegial environment and we are seeking a team oriented individual with strong clinical skills, who is passionate and enthusiastic about clinical work, professional development and developing relationships with both colleagues and clients that nurture development, respect and growth.

QUALIFICATIONS REQUIRED:

- Ph.D. in Psychology or L.C.S.W. or LMHC
- Licensed to practice psychology in NY State
- Experience in providing short-term individual psychotherapy

PREFERRED:

- Experience in providing psychological services to college age students.
- Experience in clinical settings; strong assessment and diagnostic skills.
- Experience in DBT.

JOB RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Conduct individual and group therapy and make appropriate treatment plan/ referrals/ recommendations
- Provide crisis intervention for “walk-in” students
- Outreach and support to faculty and staff as related to students
- Resource Development & Referrals – you may be asked to research, develop and compile different resource materials.
