Allegheny College, a small selective liberal arts college located in northwest Pennsylvania, invites applications for the position of Director of College Counseling. As a member of the Division of Student Life, the Director is a student-centered professional who manages the clinical team that provides counseling to Allegheny College students. It is the mission of the counseling center staff to identify and remove barriers to learning and increase students' readiness to learn.

The Director also participates on College committees and works closely with the Student Life staff in support of campus programming, crisis intervention, and consultation services for faculty and staff in as related to student persistence and retention to graduation. This full-time, eleven-month administrative position is designed to support the College's strategic priorities of inspiring and developing student leaders who are prepared to live and work in an increasingly diverse global community.

Candidates for the position must have a master's degree in counseling, social work, clinical or counseling psychology; an earned doctorate in counselor education/supervision or psychology or related field is preferred. A Pennsylvania license is expected by the start date or within 90 days of employment. Demonstrated expertise and an interest in working with students in a residential liberal arts college and experience in a Counseling Center supervising staff and providing clinical supervision is required. The position begins on or before July 1, 2017.

Allegheny College is a Carnegie I national liberal arts college that ranks among the top 7% of liberal arts colleges in the production of future Ph.D.'s, business leaders and other professionals. The *Chronicle of Higher Education* ranks Allegheny as one of the best colleges in the nation to work for, specifically in the areas of compensation and benefits. The College is located in Northwest Pennsylvania, north of Pittsburgh.
