

Georgia College is currently accepting applications for the position of Assistant Director of Counseling Services. GC and Counseling Services promote diversity, thus we encourage professionals of diverse backgrounds to apply.

GC Counseling Services provides short-term professional counseling and psychiatric services to GC students to promote student success and academic retention.

The duties of this position include the following:

- Provide individual, group and/or couples counseling to students to address personal, academic and career concerns, engage in crisis intervention to address mental health emergencies.
- Develop and leads structured groups, workshops, presentations, and other prevention and psychoeducational outreach programming.
- Assume administration duties of Counseling Services as assigned by the director.
- Provide clinical supervision for trainees and/or staff working toward obtaining full licensure. Provide consultation regarding clinical issues as needed to all Counseling Services staff.
- Work individually and on committees with faculty or staff, and external agencies for the benefit of students and the institution. Determines the most appropriate and needed areas of focus to benefit students and the institution, and seeks opportunities to become involved in those areas.
- Consult with faculty, staff and other off campus constituents (e.g., parents, mental health professionals, physicians, etc.) about the developmental and mental health needs of students.

Preferred qualifications: Doctorate in Mental Health Discipline; Licensure as a psychologist in Georgia, or ability to obtain licensure within three months of hire. Three or more years of experience in a college counseling setting. Three or more years of experiences in a supervisory position.
